

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Pursuant to Rule 31(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals ("Mechanism"), the Registrar respectfully files this fifteenth bi-monthly submission ("Submission"), in accordance with the "Further Instruction to the Registrar" dated 19 December 2022 ("Further Instruction").

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

- 2. In the Further Instruction, the President ordered the Registrar to, *inter alia*, file on the judicial record, every 60 days from 4 January 2023, reports on the Registrar's efforts to find a solution for the eight persons who were relocated on 6 December 2021 to the Republic of Niger ("Niger") following their acquittal by the International Criminal Tribunal of Rwanda or their release upon having served their respective sentences ("Relocated Persons"), in line with the Mechanism's duty of care towards them.³
- 3. On 6 March 2023, the Registrar filed the first bi-monthly report.⁴
- 4. On 8 May 2023, the Registrar filed the second bi-monthly report.⁵
- 5. On 13 June 2023, following the Registrar's request to amend the reporting period to quarterly,⁶ the President confirmed the next report was due on 10 July 2023.⁷
- 6. On 6 July 2023, the Registrar filed the third bi-monthly report.8

- 7. On 11 September 2023, the Registrar filed the fourth bi-monthly report.⁹
- 8. On 10 November 2023, the Registrar filed the fifth bi-monthly report. 10
- 9. On 9 January 2024, the Registrar filed the sixth bi-monthly report. 11
- 10. On 8 March 2024, the Registrar filed the seventh bi-monthly report. 12
- 11. On 6 May 2024, the Registrar filed the eighth bi-monthly report ("Eighth Bi-monthly Submission"). 13
- 12. On 24 June 2024, a motion was filed by Mr. François-Xavier Nzuwonemeye requesting an additional lump sum payment of 11,500 USD for each Relocated Person for 2025 and payment of the annual rent for their residence in Niger, ¹⁴ which was joined by Messrs. Alphonse Nteziryayo and André Ntagerura, who filed motions in support the following day. ¹⁵
- 13. On 5 July 2024, the Registrar filed the ninth bi-monthly report. 16
- 14. On 24 July 2024, the Single Judge in the case, *inter alia*, invited "the Registrar, within 40 days of the filing of this Order, to make preliminary enquiries with the Government of Rwanda and file written submissions regarding the relevant arrangements that could be made with the Rwandan authorities to secure the return of the Relocated Persons onto their territory and provide them with appropriate guarantees of safety, as well as any other submissions relevant to the determination of the present matter, as appropriate" ("Order").¹⁷
- 15. Between July and September 2024, the Relocated Persons filed various motions in response to the Order.¹⁸

- 16. On 2 September 2024, the Registrar filed the tenth bi-monthly report ("Tenth Submission"). 19
- 17. On 12 September 2024, the Single Judge decided, *inter alia*, to remain seized of the Motion for Additional Subsistence Funds and Joinders.²⁰
- 18. On 2 November 2024, the Registrar filed the eleventh bi-monthly report.²¹
- 19. On 22 November 2024, the Single Judge "ordered the Registrar to organize the renewal of the lease of the house of Relocated Persons in Niamey and provide necessary rental payment." The Registrar was further "ordered to provide monthly settlements at a pro-rata share, starting in January 2025 and until the conclusion of the litigation in this matter, including a possible appeal, of an additional payment of \$10,000 for the year 2025 to each of the Relocated Persons." ²³
- 20. On 6 January 2025, the Registrar filed the twelfth bi-monthly report.²⁴
- 21. On 6 March 2025, the Registrar filed the thirteenth bi-monthly report.²⁵
- 22. On 6 May 2025, the Registrar filed the fourteenth bi-monthly report.²⁶
- 23. On 20 May 2025, Mr. Alphonse Nteziryayo filed his observations on the Fourteenth Bi-monthly requesting the President to order the Registrar to file an addendum to the

- Fourteenth Bi-monthly addressing specific questions related to the ongoing discussion with the Republic of Niger.²⁷
- 24. On 30 May 2025, the President denied Mr. Nteziryayo's request, without prejudice to the Registrar's discretion to consider providing the requested information in his next submissions, as he deems appropriate.²⁸
- 25. On 4 July 2025, the Registrar filed the fifteenth bi-monthly report ("Fifteenth Submission").²⁹
- 26. On 1 August 2025, Mr. Nteziryayo filed observations regarding the Fifteenth Submission requesting the President to order the Registrar to prepare and file an addendum, addressing specific questions ("Nteziryayo's Motion").³⁰
- 27. On 29 August 2025, the President denied Mr. Nteziryayo's Motion, without prejudice to the Registrar's discretion to consider providing the requested information in his next submissions, as deemed appropriate.³¹

III. SUBMISSIONS

28. The Registry continued its efforts to find relocation States to host the Relocated Persons, in collaboration with their Counsel.³²

A. Collaboration with Counsel

- 29. The Registry continues to address the issues raised in the correspondence from the Counsel for Mr. Mugiraneza and Mr. Nzuwonemeye, respectively, mentioned in the Eighth Bi-monthly Submission.
- 30. Regarding the potential relocation State mentioned in Annex A of this Submission and in paragraph 27 of the Fifteenth Bi-monthly Submission,³³ in August 2025, the

Registry continued its collaboration with counsel regarding the potential relocation State and continues to await receipt of the requested information from the other counsel to initiate additional engagements for his client.

- 31. As for another potential relocation State mentioned in Annex A of this Submission and in paragraph 28 of the Fifteenth Bi-monthly Submission, the Registry awaits a response to its request for a working-level meeting with a representative of the Embassy to the United Republic of Tanzania to seek guidance on visa applications for family reunification.³⁴
- 32. On 25 August 2025, the Registry responded to the email from the Counsel for Mr. Innocent Sagahutu dated 27 July 2025, regarding the potential relocation State mentioned in Annex A of this Submission and in paragraph 20 of the Tenth Submission.³⁵
 - B. Exchanges with Potential Relocation States
- 33. The Registry remains engaged with the Nigerien authorities following the Registrar's mission to Niger in February 2025 to personally meet with senior Government officials to ease the restrictions on the Relocated Persons.
- 34. The Registry continued to leverage its partnership by contacting various United Nation's entities with country presence to assist the Mechanism in finding long-term solutions to the relocation challenges and extend the visibility of the United Nations Security Council's repeated calls for Member States' cooperation in receiving the Relocated Persons on their territory.
- 35. I remain available should you require any further information.
