ORDER SCHEDULING A STATUS CONFERENCE

I, PRISCA MATIMBA NYAMBE, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals (“Appeals Chamber” and “Mechanism”, respectively) and Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;¹

NOTING the judgement issued in this case by Trial Chamber I of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia on 22 November 2017;²

NOTING the notices of appeal filed by Ratko Mladić (“Mladić”) and the Office of the Prosecutor of the Mechanism on 22 March 2018,³ and the filing of their respective appellant’s briefs on 6 August 2018;⁴

NOTING that Mladić is currently in custody at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending resolution of the appeal proceedings against the Trial Judgement;

CONSIDERING that, in accordance with Rule 69(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Mechanism (“Rules”), the Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber Judge shall convene a status conference within 120 days of the filing of a notice of appeal, and thereafter within 120 days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person;

NOTING that the last status conference in this case was held on 10 July 2018;⁵

RECALLING that, in accordance with Rule 69(C)(ii) of the Rules, with the written consent of the accused, given after receiving advice from his counsel, a status conference may be conducted in the absence of the accused, but with his participation via teleconference if he so wishes;

PURSUANT to Rule 69(B) of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDER that a status conference shall be held before me on Tuesday, 6 November 2018, at 15.00, in Courtroom 1; and


