
AMENDMENT TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND EVIDENCE

Pursuant to Article 13 of the Statute and Rule 6 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) of the Mechanism for International Criminal Tribunals, Rule 24 of the Rules has been amended.

ANNEX

Rule 24

Replacement

- (A) If the President does not remain in office or is unable to carry out the functions of the President, these shall be assumed by the **Duty Judge in Arusha** ~~senior Judge, determined in accordance with Rule 22(B)~~, until such time as the Secretary-General appoints a new President.
- (B) If the President's incapacity or inability is temporary, the President's functions shall be assumed by the **Duty Judge in Arusha** ~~senior Judge, determined in accordance with Rule 22(B)~~.
- (C) If the President is unable to exercise the functions of Presiding Judge of the Appeals Chamber, that Chamber shall elect a Presiding Judge from among its members.

Article 24

Remplacement

- A) Si le Président n'est plus en fonctions ou est empêché d'exercer la présidence, celle-ci est assurée par le **juge de permanence à Arusha** ~~juge doyen désigné conformément à l'article 22-B) ci-dessus~~, jusqu'à ce que le Secrétaire général nomme un nouveau Président.
- B) Si l'incapacité ou l'empêchement du Président est temporaire, la présidence est exercée par le **juge de permanence à Arusha** ~~juge doyen désigné conformément à l'article 22-B) ci-dessus~~.
- C) Si le Président est empêché d'assurer la présidence de la Chambre d'appel, celle-ci élit son président parmi ses membres.
