In addition, the Ministry has the honour to provide the following information, based on questions it has received about these specific topics:

## Self-quarantine on arrival in the Netherlands

Travellers coming from COVID risk areas (countries or regions) can get tested on arrival, free of charge. A test centre has been set up at Amsterdam Schiphol Airport. It will scale up in the coming weeks, to allow more travellers arriving from risk areas to be tested. The list of COVID risk areas is adapted once circumstances change and is available at

The test centre is explicitly meant for arrivals and not for people leaving the Netherlands.

Travellers arriving from COVID risk areas (Dutch citizens as well as foreigners, including persons who are residing in the Netherlands) are also strongly advised to self-quarantine for 10 days, even if they do not have any symptoms or if they have tested negative for Covid-19. They can self-quarantine at home or in temporary or holiday accommodation. The advice to self-quarantine also applies to persons who have been in contact with someone who has tested positive. The OMT has advised that the quarantine period can be reduced from 14 days to 10 days.
