

ICTY Remembers: The Srebrenica Genocide (1995–2015)



First convictions for
genocide
in Europe

to be entered by an international criminal tribunal

Approximately

7,000 persons
killed

based on evidence presented in different trials

Srebrenica, Bosnia and Herzegovina

July 1995 - After 3 years under siege

42,000 inhabitants
of which

36,000 refugees



20 individuals indicted
by the ICTY

for crimes committed in Srebrenica in 1995
